Here are a series of screen grabs which I hope show how to copy a web address to paste in a post.

Here is a topic that had no web link posted which would have made life easier for all if a link had been posted.



This screen grab (Figure 2) shows where the web address is.

This is the URL or web address



If you move the cursor in to the web address location say immediately after the 'm' in recoainc.com' and left click (single click) with your mouse, or perform the action equivalent to a double click, the web address will be selected as in this screengrab (Figure 3)



If you then right click with your mouse, or perform the action equivalent to right clicking, a drop-down menu will occur as in Figure 4.



If you select copy as in this screengrab (Figure 5) then the web address will be copied to the clipboard of the computer, tablet or phone you are working from. You can now paste this link in a post if you wish by either using the control key on your keyboard with v together 'ctrl'+v' will paste the clipboard text into any text editor such as making a post to recoainc. Or you could simply use right click on your mouse, or equivalent function, and select the paste option. Click on the quotation mark button highlighted.



Either right click in the reply window and select paste or use 'ctrl'+v' together and paste your copied web address in to your reply. Alternatively, you can use the BBcode URL button, circled in red, to create the link in your post that you can label how you like, by carefully typing = in the first url bracket [url=] then pasting your web address immediately after the '=' and before ']', carefully see how it is done below. You can then type an English phrase that will be your highlighted link in your reply. See the code below.
